* Mr. Bingham's background prior to founding EEI includes extensive experience in all aspects of Civil & Structural Engineering, highlighted by his 6 years at <u>Walt Disney</u> <u>Imagineering</u> as Chief Structural Engineer for the EPCOT project.

* Currently Kent is working with the <u>University of Nevada</u> in Las Vegas as a consultant to their new Entertainment Engineering program. The stated objective of this program is to teach students how to design and build anything that they can imagine.

* Kent Bingham served <u>Walt Disney Imagineering</u> as Chief Structural Engineer from 1977 thru 1983. He did the preliminary design for all of the structures at EPCOT. His role was to fully integrate all aspects of facility, show, & ride systems. EEI prepared all of the show & ride drawing packages for the modern opening of Euro Disneyland. They also designed new & improved versions of Rocket to Mars & Dumbo, specially created for this opening.

* <u>EEI</u> worked on most of the spectacular show systems in Las Vegas during the period from 1993 thru 2001, including the Star Trek show at the Hilton and the Las Vegas Monorail.

* Mr. Bingham's accomplishments at <u>Universal Studios</u> in Hollywood & Orlando include, but are not limited to: Earthquake – USH; King Kong – USH; NASCAR – City Walk; King Kong – USF and Roboasis animated show – USF.
